RESOLUTION NO. 2019 - 01

AMENDING ARTICLE 1 OF THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF
THE HANOVER TOWNSHIP SEWER AUTHORITY

WHEREAS, the Hanover Township Sewer Authority ("HTSA"), its Authority's Agents, and representatives are expressly authorized by the laws of this Commonwealth to perform any and all acts and things necessary for its business and the general welfare of HTSA which may from time to time require entry on to property owned or leased by a Customer.

WHEREAS, the welfare of HTSA and the health and safety of its Authority's agents, and representatives is of paramount concern to HTSA, and of critical importance to the operation and function of HTSA.

WHEREAS, certain Customers have attempted to prevent access to their properties by HTSA Authority's agents, and representatives through methods which endanger the health and safety of the same.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of the Hanover Township Sewer Authority, Washington County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby RESOLVED by the Authority that Article 1,;


"Section 11. Interference with or Obstruction of Authority Business by Customer

1. Any Customer who interferes with or obstructs any business by an Authority's Agent or representative which that Authority's Agent or Representative deems necessary for the business and general welfare of the authority which necessitates access to that Customer's property shall be prosecuted for a summary offense, with a maximum fine of \$300.00.
2. For the purposes of this paragraph "interferes with or obstructions" can include, but is not limited to preventing access to the property by: a gate, fence, or other similar installation; the threatening in any manner of an Authority's Agent or representative by a customer, or any individual situated on the property at the time of the Authority's Agents or representatives attempted access to the property; the use of any threatening mechanism or chattel including spring guns, animals or livestock of any kind to deter or prevent access to the property by an Authority's Agents or Representative.
3. All fees or cost of any kind associated with the service call, or other business of the authority that was interfered with or obstructed will be immediately applied to the account of the Customer."


